The Pick Group Board Development Training Program (BDTP) is designed to educate participants on the responsibilities of serving on non-profit boards. Community leaders will facilitate each class session providing insight and focused training about the roles and responsibilities of board participation and the importance of professional relationships with non-profits.

Participant Expectations

Upon acceptance, all BDTP participants are expected to attend all meetings and events listed below as well as one non-profit board meeting as a guest. Participants must be prompt and stay for the full duration of each class, actively engaging in discussions and exercises. There is a **tuition fee of \$75 for Pick Group members** (to be paid in full or in 3 installments) and **\$100 for non-members** (to be paid in full or in 4 installments) to cover class materials and meals. Post-grads are expected to serve on a local non-profit board and will be encouraged to attend a board meeting during the program.
